

The Mediapolis City Council met in regular session on 9/14/20. Mayor Young called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present – Doyle, Massner, Licko, Kerr, and Garrison. Visitors – Ned Fry, Brian Carter, Lieutenant McCune, Casey Koniarski, Jay Brady, and Eric Schallert

Motion by Massner seconded by Doyle to amend and approve the agenda by adding Change Order #2 for Visu-Sewer. All ayes.

Motion by Licko seconded by Kerr to approve the Consent Agenda – Minutes, Expenses, Clerk, and Library Reports. Approve a Building Permit for a Shed at 218 S. Sunnyside St. – Tom Wagner. All ayes.

Sheriff's Report was presented by Lieutenant McCune.

Motion by Doyle seconded by Garrison to approve Contract 1 – Pipe and Manhole Rehabilitation Change Order #2 for Visu-Sewer to extend the contract completion date to October 30th, 2020. All ayes.

Brian Carter was present to discuss with the council on the status of the Hwy 61 project. A sub-committee has been put together to discuss further details.

Casey, Jay, and Eric with Stanley Consultants gave the council an update on the NAN02 System and Phase 2 project. Sewer construction has been completed and over 600 feet of pipe rerouted or replaced. There were 6 new manholes constructed along with 5 manholes that were removed and replaced along with grouted and chimney sealed. Visu-Sewer is still in the process of finishing the lining of the sewer lines and plan for a completion date of October 30th, 2020.

Council would like planning and zoning opinion on rezoning from a C-1 to a C-2 District.

Motion by Kerr seconded by Massner to approve Temple Display, Ltd purchase for new holiday lights along the main street. All ayes.

Motion by Licko seconded by Doyle to approve using the Mediapolis Memorial Trust Fund of \$1,241.05 towards a table to be placed out at the sports complex in front of the concession stand. All ayes.

Council reviewed and discussed the current animal ordinance.

Motion by Massner seconded by Licko to set Trick or Treat for Saturday, October 31st from 5:00 – 7:00 PM. All ayes.

Motion by Garrison seconded by Licko to approve **Resolution 16-2020 approving the Street Finance Report for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2020**. After a unanimous roll call vote, the mayor declared the resolution duly adopted.

Motion by Doyle seconded by Massner to table 5-2020 until the next meeting. All ayes. Motion by Garrison seconded by Doyle to table 12-2020, and 13-2020 until the next meeting. All ayes. Motion by Doyle seconded by Massner to send a 14-day letter to 14-2020 and 15-2020. All ayes.
